Climate: mostly desert; hot and humid along west coast; temperate in western mountains affected by seasonal monsoon; extraordinarily hot, dry, harsh desert in east **Terrain:** narrow coastal plain backed by flat-topped hills and rugged mountains; dissected upland desert plains in center slope into the desert interior of the Arabian Peninsula **Natural Hazards:** sandstorms and dust storms in summer

Population: 21.5 million (UN, 2005)
Ethnicity: predominantly Arab; but also Afro-Arab, South Asians, Europeans
Major Language: Arabic
Religion: Muslim including Shaf'i (Sunni) and Zaydi (Shi'a), small numbers of Jewish, Christian, and Hindu
Life expectancy: 59 years (men), 62 years (women) (UN)

Currency: 1 Yemeni riyal = 100 fils
